



Any other use, not mentioned under intended use, is regarded as non-intended and incorrect use.

## 3. Description of the Product

The Showgear RCA-WMF-6 6U / RCA-WMF-9 9U / RCA-WMF-15 15U is a lockable 19" wall-mount rack case with a 6 rack / 9 rack / 15 rack unit height and two ventilation grilles, suitable for fixed installations. This black 19 inch rack case has a metal body with glass plates and is only for indoor use. The RCA-WMF-6 6U / RCA-WMF-9 9U / RCA-WMF-15 15U comes with a 19" installation kit, bolt & washer, cage nut, hex key, keys, and screws.







Fig. 11 Fig. 12






Fig. 13 Fig. 14

## 4. Installation

## 4.1. Safety Instructions for Installation



#### **WARNING**

Incorrect installation can cause serious injuries and damage of property.

Due to incorrect installation this product may fall, causing serious personal injury and material damage.

Make sure that the structure, where this cabinet is installed, can carry at least 4 times the weight of the cabinet and all equipment installed in the cabinet.

It is not recommended to mount the cabinet on a wooden wall or on drywall panels.

Installation must be carried out only by instructed or skilled persons.

#### 4.2. Installation Site Requirements



#### **Attention**

Make sure that there is enough space for ventilation around the cabinet.

The cabinet must be installed only indoors.

Keep the cabinet away from moisture, temperature extremes, flammable liquids and gasses, conductive contaminants, dust and direct sunlight.

#### 4.3. Tools for Mounting

To mount the product, you need:

- Phillips screwdriver (PH1)
- Anchors
- Drill bits
- Power drill
- Ruler
- Water Level



## 4.4. Cabinet Mounting

Make sure that the mounting hardware is suitable for the structure where the cabinet will be installed.

- 01) Select the place where you want to install the cabinet.
- 02) Use the **wall bracket (H)** of the cabinet as a template and mark the drilling locations. Make sure that the alignment is correct as shown in Fig. 15.



03) Drill pilot holes at the 4 marked locations, as shown in Fig. 16 and Fig. 17.



- 04) Unpack all packages and carefully lay the parts out on the floor.




Fig. 18 Fig. 19

- 05) Attach the wall bracket (H) to the wall with the correct anchors and screws, as shown in Fig. 18.
- 06) Make sure that the wall bracket (H) is firmly secured and leveled, as shown in Fig. 19.

## Attention Heavy object

This product is heavy. Minimum two persons are necessary to mount the cabinet.




Fig. 20 Fig. 21

07) Hang the cabinet on the wall bracket (H), as shown in Fig. 20 and Fig. 21.




Fig. 22 Fig. 23

- 08) Open the door of the cabinet and put the 2 safety screws (D) into the holes, as shown in Fig. 22.
- 09) Tighten the safety screws (D) and make sure that the cabinet is firmly secured, as shown in Fig. 23.
- 10) Use the **keys (G)** to lock and unlock the doors. The cabinet is now ready for use.

11) Make sure that the cabinet is completely leveled before you install equipment.

## 4.5. Equipment Installation

Incorrect use of this product may cause personal injury and material damage.

- Make sure that the cabinet is fully mounted and secured before you install equipment in the cabinet.
- Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of the cabinet. Make sure that the cabinet can support
  the total weight of all equipment installed.
- Do not put any object on the cabinet.

You can install standard 19-inch equipment into the server rack cabinet. The inside dimensions of the server rack cabinet are as follows:


- D7652 RCA-WMF-6: 6 U
- D7653 RCA-WMF-9: 9 U
- D7654 RCA-WMF-15: 15 U

1 rack unit is 44,45 mm high.



To mount equipment, follow the steps below:

- 01) Put 4 **cage nuts (A)** in front of the holes on the vertical brackets at the place where you want to mount the equipment, as shown in Fig. 24.
- 02) Insert one side of the cage nut (A) into the vertical bracket, as shown in Fig. 25.




Fig. 26 Fig. 27

- 03) Press the other side of the cage nut (A) and push it through the hole, as shown in Fig. 26.
- 04) Repeat steps 2–3 to install the other 3 cage nuts (A).
- 05) Put the equipment in front of the cabinet at the place where the 4 **cage nuts (A)** are installed. Make sure that the mounting holes on the equipment are aligned with the **cage nuts (A)**, as shown in Fig. 27.
- 06) Use a screwdriver to mount the equipment to the vertical brackets with 4 screws (C).
- 07) Tighten the 4 screws (C) to make sure that the equipment cannot move.

## 5. Maintenance

#### 5.1. Preventive Maintenance



Attention

Before use, examine the cabinet visually for any defects.

Make sure that:

- All screws used for installing the cabinet are tightly fastened and are not corroded.
- There are no deformations on materials.

#### 5.1.1. Basic Cleaning Instructions

The ventilation openings must be cleaned periodically in order to optimize airflow and keep the installed equipment dust-free. The cleaning schedule depends on the conditions at the site where the cabinet is installed.



#### **Attention**

Do not use alcohol or solvents.

To clean the product, follow the steps below:

- 01) Clean the product with a soft, lint-free cloth.
- 02) Remove dust from the ventilation openings with an air compressor, vacuum cleaner or a soft brush.

#### 5.2. Corrective Maintenance

The product does not contain user-serviceable parts. Do not modify the product.

Refer repairs and servicing to instructed or skilled persons. Contact your Highlite International dealer for more information.



## 6. Deinstallation, Transportation and Storage

#### 6.1. Instructions for Deinstallation



#### Attention Heavy object

This product is heavy. Minimum two persons are necessary to mount or to move the cabinet.

- Deinstallation must be carried out only by instructed or skilled persons.
- Do not put any equipment on the cabinet.

To deinstall the product, follow the steps below:

- 01) Remove the installed equipment from the cabinet.
- 02) Clean the cabinet. See **5.1.1. Basic Cleaning Instructions** on page 18.

## 6.2. Instructions for Transportation

- Use the original packaging to transport the product, if possible.
- Always observe the handling instructions printed on the outer carton box, for example: "Handle with care", "This side up", "Fragile".

## 6.3. Storage

- Inspect the product for defects before storing. See 5.1. Preventive Maintenance on page 18 for more information.
- Clean the product before storing. Follow the cleaning instructions in chapter 5.1.1. Basic Cleaning Instructions on page 18.
- Store the product in the original packaging, if possible.

## 7. Disposal

After the product is removed from service all metal parts can be disposed of as scrap. The plastic and rubber parts of this product shall not be treated as household waste. Dispose of these plastic and rubber parts by handing it to the respective collection point for recycling. This is to avoid environmental damage or personal injury due to uncontrolled waste disposal. For more detailed information about recycling of this product contact the local authorities or the authorized dealer
